2023 Athens Township Paving ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the 2023 ATHENS TOWNSHIP PAVING PROJECT will received by the Board of Athens Township Trustees, Athens County, Ohio, at the Township Hall, 313 W. Union St, Athens Ohio until 5:00 p.m., on the 27nd day of December, 2022 and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids will be considered valid until 60 days after the opening date, although not accepted or rejected. Bids may be mailed but must be received by the 5 pm deadline.

The work for which proposals are invited consists of a 2" asphalt paving on various sections of multiple roads of the 112 lane miles of the Athens Township road system. This shall be bid on a unit price basis and prices shall be good until 11/30/2023, unless the ODOT Asphalt Binder Index fluctuates more that 10% and then adjustments may be negotiated. Either side can request dispensation when the +or- 10% threshold is met.

A considerable amount of this work is attached to an area of the Township where the Athens County Water & Sewer District has recently constructed a new sewer system,

We are requesting unit prices for the paving to be used on an "as needed" basis calling for a varying timeline and projects.

- Mobilization costs shall be a function of the associated unit price.
- The township commits to combining multiple roads in a same general vicinity to each other with a goal of no less than 150 cubic yards.
- There will be some milling required on an as needed basis and shall be included as an yd² price.
- Line painting price on as needed basis and shall be per foot unit price.
- The Township budget for this contract has been set not to exceed \$400,000.
- Contractor shall make every effort to maintain local traffic.
 - We do not anticipate road closures it is required of the contractor to notify the trustees as well as the Athens County 911 system so first responders have proper notice.
- All traffic control is by the contractor and shall be a function of the associated unit price.

Each bid shall have filed with it a bid guaranty in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit revocable only at the option of Athens Township in an amount equal to 10% of the bid <u>or</u> a bond in accordance with division (B) of Section 153.54 of the Revised Code.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. The project completion date is November 30, 2023.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Athens County as determined by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration. Certified payroll shall be included with requests for payment.

The Board of Athens Township Trustees, Athens County, Ohio reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive informalities as may be in the best interest of Athens Township.

2023 Athens Township Paving SUPLIMENTAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

1) Disbursements to the Contractor

The Owner shall require that as work on the Project and as specified in its contract is performed,

The Contractor shall:

- A. Complete agreed upon sections of project section according to terms and conditions as stated, then promptly submit an invoice to the Township for payment.
- B. The Township shall Within three (3) business days following receipt of such invoice from a Contractor, review the invoice and, if found to be accurate, including; agreed scope of work, quality and quantities (evidenced by weight slips) the Township representative then shall approve and submit the invoice to the Fiscal Officer for payment.
- C. Athens Township checks are signed and released for payment on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month. An invoice submitted no less than 5 days prior to a scheduled meeting shall be processed and paid at that meeting. If submitted less than 5 days it will be released for payment at the following meeting.

2) Prevailing Wage and workers

- A. Contractors and subcontractor working on the Project **shall comply with** the **prevailing wage** requirements contained in Sections 4115.03 to 4115.16 of the Ohio Revised Code. Certified payroll logs and weight slip documentation SHALL be submitted with payment requests.
- B. Contractor shall be current for Workers Compensation and provide proof.

3) Contractor must be insured.

A. No less than \$1,000,000 and provide proof.

4) Ohio Products

- A. The Contractor shall, to the extent practicable, use, and shall cause any of its subcontractors to use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in connection with the Project.
- B. The contractor is responsible all prevailing wage documentation from any sub-contractor.

4. <u>Domestic Steel Use Requirements</u>

A. Domestic steel use requirements as specified in Section 153.011 of the Revised Code apply to this project. Copies of Section 153.011 of the Revised Code can be obtained from any of the offices of the DAS

5. WORK SPECIFICATIONS

- A. Work as proposed under this contract shall consist of:
 - 1) Properly sweeping the road surfaces. **All** roadway surfaces **shall** be swept before applying the tack.
 - 2) Applying an asphalt tack coat (ODOT 407) at the rate of 0.1 gal/SY with 100% coverage,
 - 3) Emplacing an asphalt concrete scratch course (ODOT 448) for leveling and smoothing purposes
 - 4) Emplacing an asphalt concrete finish course (ODOT 448).
 - i. The width to be paved is the width of the existing pavement or as agreed upon.
 - ii. The depth shall be a minimum of 2.0 inches.

- B. The base/finish course will be used to bring low areas of the existing pavement up to the existing normal surface and to smooth extremely rough portions of the roadway or for proper road drainage.
- C. Contractor shall mill butt joints at tie-in locations; including driveways, if necessary, as well as around all catch basins.
- D. All driveway transitions shall be tapered, milled or eased for the convenience of the property owners.
- E. The Contractor must have previously and continue to supply Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) certified products and conform to ODOT specifications. The right is reserved by the Athens Township Trustees to inspect the bidder's plant and equipment.
- F. All materials must meet or exceed ODOT specifications as set forth in the ODOT Construction and Materials Specifications Handbook.
- G. Should concern develop with field performance, the bidder shall provide immediate technical assistance to resolve such problems.
- H. The contractor shall maintain two-way traffic at all times. All traffic control methods shall be in accordance with the ODOT Manual of Traffic Control for Construction and Maintenance Operations. All such costs shall be included in the cost of the bid items.
